Subject: Byllesby-Buck Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2514-186)

Filing of Amended Final License Application

Dear Secretary Bose:

Appalachian Power Company (Appalachian or Licensee), a unit of American Electric Power (AEP), is the Licensee, owner, and operator of the 30.1-megawatt, two-development Byllesby-Buck Hydroelectric Project (Project) (Project No. 2514), located on the upper New River in Carroll County, Virginia.

The Project is currently licensed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission). The Project underwent relicensing in the early 1990s and the current operating license for the Project expires on February 29, 2024. Accordingly, Appalachian is pursuing a new license for the Project pursuant to the Commission's Integrated Licensing Process (ILP), as described at 18 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 5. In accordance with 18 CFR § 5.17(a), Appalachian filed the Final License Application (FLA) for the Project on February 28, 2022. Appalachian filed the Revised Aquatic Resources and Bypass Reach Flow and Aquatic Habitat Study Reports as supplemental information 45 days after filing the FLA (April 14, 2022), which allowed the Licensee additional time to conduct more in-depth study analyses to address FERC and agency comments on the Draft License Application and Updated Study Report.

Appalachian is filing this amended FLA for the Project because, subsequent to filing its FLA, Appalachian, agencies, and other stakeholders continued to meet regarding agencies' interests in protection, mitigation, and enhancement (PM&E) measures that were not included in the original FLA. Appalachian has updated several of its application exhibits to reflect new proposed measures to address these interests. For the convenience of the Commission staff and relicensing participants, new language in the amended FLA is included in tracked changes and clarifying footnotes have been added throughout. Application exhibits not affected by the proposed changes have not been refiled and are incorporated by reference.

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The amended FLA contains three volumes¹, two of which Appalachian considers public information and one that contains Critical Energy/Electric Infrastructure Information (CEII). The updated volumes and exhibits in the amended FLA are as follows:

A comprehensive listing and summary of all components of the amended FLA, including those not being re-filed at this time, is provided in Table ES-3 of Volume I of the amended FLA.

Summary of Measures Proposed in the Amended FLA

In addition to upgrades to turbine-generator units at both developments, in the amended FLA, Appalachian proposes replacement of several wooden flashboard bays at each development's spillway with inflatable Obermeyer gates to reduce the frequency of reservoir drawdowns (for flashboard repair or reinstallation) and to provide additional means and locations for controlled spillway discharges. Appalachian is also proposing to operate Obermeyer gates to provide a continuous bypass reach minimum flow of approximately 35 cubic feet per second (cfs) at the Byllesby Development and a seasonal (February 15th – May 15th) continuous bypass reach minimum flow of approximately 100 cfs at the Buck Development. The amended FLA provides for additional PM&E measures related to aquatic species, aquatic and terrestrial habitat, and recreation associated with the Project. Proposals presented in the amended FLA reflect careful consideration of available information, the results of studies conducted, and issues specific to the Project. Appalachian believes these proposed PM&E measures appropriately take into

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consideration the important power and non-power values of the Project, the diverse interests of stakeholders, and the physical and social context of the Project.
